4. Applicant must be from a local area North Dakota high school
5. A verification statement must be included with this form stating that the applicant is in good standing for graduation from their school this spring. (To be completed by the student's guidance counselor and secondary principal)
6. Primary consideration will be given to dependents of Dakota Cruiser members followed by non-member students
7. Scholarship is for \$500 payable to the student and post high school institution and must be used for tuition/materials expenses related to the course of study.

Attention Area Guidance Counselors:

The Dakota Cruisers car club of Minot will again be awarding \$500 scholarships to students from area schools who will be pursuing a career in automotive repair and/or restoration. Students must be enrolled or plan on enrolling in a vocational college in North Dakota with additional consideration given for accredited, approved out-of-state institutions.(subject to Dakota Cruiser approval)

Prime consideration will be given to dependents of “Cruiser” members before awarding scholarships to other students. The number of scholarships to be awarded will depend on the amount of funds available. Dakota Cruisers **has not** declined applicants in the past for a lack of funding.

The decision to award scholarships to students will be made by the board of directors of the Dakota Cruisers. Applicants will be notified of the award following the May 6, 2020 meeting.

Funds will be awarded in the form of a check made out jointly to the student and institution. Dakota Cruisers requests that presentation of the check be made to the recipient at a monthly meeting of the club but is not a requirement.
